

Host Families Needed for Australian Students



The opportunity to host a foreign student from Australia is available for those students who sign up by leaving a name, phone number and email address for the School Coordinator to contact. To host an Australian student, families must be able to provide "room & board". That means meals and a bed. Aussies students do NOT need to have their own room, but they DO need to have their own bed. Meals are provided by the host family.

Aussie students go to school with your Santana student in the morning. A tour bus picks them up from Santana each weekday morning around 8 a.m. The group tours San Diego areas while your student is at school. The bus arrives back to Santana approximately 5 p.m. each weekday evening. Getting back to the host family home in the evening is the responsibility of the host family (students CAN walk home).

The good part about this exchange program is it's only TEN DAYS, the Aussies speak English and you only have to entertain them on the weekends!
