Release of Liability

If you're a senior and would like to attend our drug and alcohol free Sober Grad party **June 6, 2019**, there are some rules. Any graduate, who engages in prohibited behavior, including but not limited to possessing or being under the influence of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol, or engages in any other undesirable conduct, will be removed from the event at the discretion of the Sober Grad Night committee and chaperones. If this should occur, the student may be left in the custody of local authorities and parents will be notified and responsible for arranging student's release and transportation, or the parent(s) guardian will be contacted and required to pick up the student from the party venue. No refunds will be granted. The student (if over 18 years of age) or parent(s) guardian are liable for the full replacement cost of any and all loss or damage to any persons or property that is directly or indirectly caused by the graduate. The Sober Grad Night celebration is not a school sponsored event and Santana High School assumes no legal liability associated with this event.

1. Tickets can be purchased with a check, cash or money order or VENMO & can be made out to Santana PTSA and mailed to Santana High School PTSA, Attn. Grad Night, 9915 N. Magnolia Ave. Santee, CA 92071. This form needs to be signed and turned in with payment.
2. It can be mailed or brought to Kim Smith in the attendance office. Receipts available upon request.
3. Students will depart from Santana High School (by the gym) on June 6th at approximately 11:00am and should check in at the back of the school between 10:30-10:45am. If a student misses the bus, they will NOT be offered a refund. ALL students attending the event must meet at Santana and travel on the chartered bus. Students are NOT allowed to travel to Universal Studios by any other method.
4. Students will return to Santana on June 7th at approximately 4:00am. (Grad Night ends at 2:00am).
4. It is **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED** that students do NOT leave their vehicles in the Santana Parking Lot, as Santana High School and the PTSA do not provide overnight security.
5. Santana Chaperones will be present (Approximately 1 per 20 students) and security will be provided by Universal Studios.
6. Students may be subjected to a search for alcohol, drugs, and other contraband before boarding buses and admittance to Universal Studios. See above (Release of Liability) for more information.
7. Bags, purse, backpack smaller than 24"long and 15"wide by 18 high. Water and snacks will be provided on the bus.

Universal Studios Hollywood's Grad Bash is a once-a-year school event requiring enforcement of a dress code to ensure proper dress/attire for students and chaperones. All outfits must remain intact for the entire Universal Studios Hollywood's Grad Bash event and any Pre or Post Parties. We thank you in advance for your cooperation with our dress code.

ACCEPTABLE ATTIRE: *Note Customized "Class of 2019" or "Seniors" T-shirts are acceptable as long as there is no specific school identifiers on them.*

UNACCEPTABLE ATTIRE

- Clothing affiliated with any high school, sports team, group, club etc.
- Clothing or accessories with area codes
- Belts, wallet chains, or jewelry of any kind containing spikes
- Extremely revealing clothing including: bathing suit tops or bottoms
- Sheer Clothing, or see-through clothing of any kind
- Bare midriffs, visible undergarments
- Any clothing deemed inappropriate at a school function
- Guys may not wear tank tops or undershirts
- Clothing or tattoos with language or graphics that are obscene, offensive or suggestive of sexual, vulgar, drug, alcohol, or tobacco-related messaging
- No matching or like attire amongst students including team shirts of any kind, high school, college, or professional
- No team jerseys of any kind, high school, college, or professional
- Hats and other head attire
- Girls may not wear tube tops, tube top dresses, one shoulder shirts or any off the shoulder dresses or backless clothing of any kind.
- Large backpacks, camera bags, tote bags, and oversized purses larger than 8.5" X 5.5"

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Weapons, knives, laser pointers, and chemical irritants of any kind
- Over-the-counter medications; electronic cigarettes, tobacco or tobacco related products such as lighters, matches, pipes, etc.; and alcohol or any controlled substance.
- Any containers with fluids of any kind; this includes water, any drinks and perfumes
- Aerosol cans/bottles of any type

PLEASE NOTE: *Some schools may enforce a stricter dress code.*

Universal Studios Hollywood team members and Event Staff have the right to refuse admission to anyone whom they deem to be dressed inappropriately for the event and not in compliance with these guidelines, and will continue to enforce this dress code throughout the event. Dates and times are subject to change without notice.

Code of Conduct

Welcome to Universal Studios Hollywood and Universal CityWalk ("Universal"). In order to ensure that your visit and that of your fellow guests is pleasant, we request that all visitors to Universal comply with the following Code of Conduct:

1. Do not physically or verbally threaten or harass any person. Fighting, use of physical force, obscene or sexually explicit language or gestures, or racial, religious or ethnic slurs, including any display on apparel or via body art likely to create a disturbance or a danger to other persons, are prohibited.
2. Do not possess any item that could be used as a weapon, including, but not limited to: firearms, explosives, fireworks, clubs or sticks over 1/4 inch in diameter, chemical dispensing devices, knives with blades over 2 inches in length, or any other object(s) that may be used in any way to inflict bodily injury on another person.
3. Do not yell, scream, sing, play musical instruments, radios, audio players or other sound amplification devices, or otherwise communicate in a manner which creates noise of sufficient volume to disturb the ambient noise level of Universal or impinge on the hearing or peace of other persons beyond a ten (10) foot radius.
4. Visitors must be fully clothed, including shoes and shirts. Visitors may not wear any covering that fully or partially obscures their face unless for religious or medical reasons. Clothing that Universal construes as indecent, exposes excessive portions of the skin, or that Universal views as inappropriate for a family environment is prohibited.
5. Do not run, skate, rollerblade, skateboard, ride a bicycle or scooter, or use wheeled shoes. Do not obstruct or interfere with the free flow of pedestrian traffic.
6. Do not discard litter of any kind except in designated trash receptacles. Rummaging through or removing items from the trash receptacles or coin fountains are prohibited. Spitting is prohibited. Urinating anywhere except at designated restrooms is prohibited.
7. Do not deface, damage or destroy any property belonging to Universal, its merchants or other persons.
8. Use or possession of any illegal substances or paraphernalia is prohibited. Smoking is not permitted during event.
9. No photographing or videotaping for commercial purposes without Universal's prior consent. No photographing or videotaping in a manner that is harassing or disruptive to Universal's merchants or other persons.
10. Do not solicit money or other contributions or donations, or sell admission tickets to CityWalk and/or Universal Studios Hollywood or Gibson Amphitheatre, or distribute commercial advertising or promotional material of any kind, or offer samples of items which are sold or available for sale.
11. Do not sit on handrails, stairs, escalators, trash receptacles or other areas not specifically designed for sitting. No occupied wheelchairs are allowed on escalators.
12. Do not bring any animals on to Universal's property with the exception of service animals providing assistance to disabled persons and/or in the company of persons claiming to be a trainer of a service animal.
13. Daytime curfews (Los Angeles Municipal Code 45.04) and nighttime curfews (Los Angeles Municipal Code 45.03, unless accompanied by an adult after 10:00 p.m.) will be enforced.
14. Line jumping where the use of a queuing system is employed is prohibited.
15. Coolers, food purchased off of the property, any container or vessel containing food or any container of beverages is not permitted in the park. Exceptions may be made in advance for medical, special dietary or religious reasons only (see medical form).
16. All bags, backpacks and purses are subject to inspection by Universal security without advance notice and should not be left unattended.
17. Do not violate any federal, state or local law or ordinance. Failure to comply with all posted rules, signs, warnings and policies is prohibited.

Violators of this Code of Conduct will be asked to leave the Universal's property and may be cited for trespass or violation of local, state or federal law and/or may be arrested by local law enforcement agencies.
